

TABLE ROCK SOCCER CLUB
REFEREE GUIDELINES

1. Referees will conduct themselves in a responsible manner working closely with the referee coordinator and following his/her guidelines and procedures.
2. Referees will be notified during the week prior to games to schedule assignments.
3. Referees will be assigned games based on experience, age level, ability and availability. Referees will only be assigned to games at divisions below their own age level.
4. If an emergency situation arises and a referee cannot officiate a specific game, the referee is expected to call the referee coordinator. If you are assigned a game to which you do not show-up or if you cancel the morning of the game, you will not be scheduled for the following week.
5. Referees will be given a log sheet and a plastic bag to keep track of games cards. A completed log sheet and games cards must be turned in all together as soon as possible within ten days following the last game of the season in order to receive payment.
6. Equipment needed for all levels:
 - Black TRSC referee shirt (provided by club)
 - Black shorts (referee provided)
 - Whistle (provided by club)
 - Stop Watch or wrist watch (referee provided)
 - Rules (provided by club)
7. Referees must follow TRSC guidelines for each specified age level. These guidelines closing follow FIFA recommendations. There are, however, some exceptions. Please refer to club guidelines for specific rules and exceptions.
8. Referees are expected to review "Laws of the Game" which are posted on Table Rock Soccer Clubs web page www.tablerocksoccer.com.
